

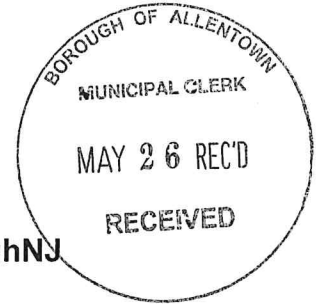

COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE GRACE PERIOD FOR TAX DUE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order Number 130 in response to the public health emergency resulting from the danger of the Coronavirus; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Allentown to provide adequate relief for the residents of the Borough believe the grace period for the payment of taxes for the second quarter of 2020 should be extended; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Governing Body of the Borough of the Borough of Allentown, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the grace period for the payment of property taxes in the Borough of Allentown for the second quarter of 2020 be and the same is hereby extended to June 1, 2020.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that interest shall only be charged on second quarter property taxes by the Tax Collector for payments received after June 1, 2020.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this resolution be sent to the Tax Collector, Deputy Tax Collector, Chief Financial Officer, Tax Assessor, and the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
