ORDINANCE NO. 02-2025

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-58: "ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION" OF CHAPTER 2: "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE BOROUGH'S REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES TO AUTHORIZE AND ESTABLISH AN ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION TRUST FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allentown, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 2: "Administration" of the Borough's Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken text~~ indicates deletions, underlined text indicates additions):

CHAPTER 2: "ADMINISTRATION"

2-58 ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION.

2-58.9 Appropriations/Trust Fund.

- a. Appropriations. The Borough Council shall annually fix, determine and appropriate a sum sufficient for the care, custody, policing and maintenance of such lands acquired for the uses and purposes herein stated, and for the expenses of the Commission, which shall be raised by taxation in the same manner as other taxes.
- b. Trust Fund. There is hereby established an Allentown Environmental Commission Trust Fund, which shall be administered in accordance with applicable local government finance laws and shall be used for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the Allentown Environmental Commission and its activities. All donations, contributions, funds, or monies received by the Commission shall be paid over to the Borough CFO and be kept by him or her in the Environmental Commission Trust Fund, which shall be under the control of the Commission. Payments from the Trust Fund shall be made to vendors under the rules and policies set forth in the Purchasing Procedures section of this Code.
- c. Disbursements/Expenses. All matters regarding expenses shall be brought forth to the Commission Members at their regularly scheduled meetings and shall be voted upon for payment. The Council Liaison is responsible to ensure that financial matters are in good order, after conferring with the Borough CFO. A formal report by the Council Liaison regarding the financial status of the Commission will be given at each regularly scheduled meeting.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by Mayor and Council that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies only.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by Mayor and Council that this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after final passage and publication according to law.
