ORDINANCE NO. 05-2022

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13: "FIRE PREVENTION" OF THE  
BOROUGH'S REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES TO INCREASE CERTAIN  
INSPECTION AND REGISTRATION FEES TO COVER ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allentown, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 13: "Fire Prevention" of the Borough's Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended as follows (~~stricken text~~ indicates deletions, underlined text indicates additions):

CHAPTER 13: "FIRE PREVENTION"

13-3 ADDITIONAL REQUIRED INSPECTIONS AND FEES.

\* \* \*

13-3.1 Annual Inspections.

In addition to the fees and inspections of life hazard uses pursuant to the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code, the additional inspections and fees relative to the non-life hazards as set forth below shall be required annually. ~~Fees shall be billed out in January and due no later than 60 days from the issuance of the bill, with a late charge of 1/2 of the original fee.~~ Fees shall be billed out at time of inspection and due no later than thirty (30) days from the issuance of the bill, with a late charge equal to the original fee added to the amount due.

13-3.1 Annual Registration Fees.

Any and all business, commercial, retail, or other premises to which the public is invited, for which provision is not made for a permit under the Uniform Fire Code, shall be inspected on an annual basis. Annual registration fees charged for inspections conducted pursuant to this section shall be:

a. *Assembly Use Group.*

A-1	Eating establishment under 50 persons	<del>\$50</del> -\$125
A-2	Take out service (no seating)	<del>\$50</del> -\$125
A-3	House of worship not used exclusively for religious purposes	N/C
A-4	Recreational centers multipurpose (fewer than 50 persons)	\$50
A-5	Court rooms, library, condo center Fraternal organizations (fewer than 50 persons)	\$50
A-6	Senior centers (fewer than 50 persons)	\$50

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that any ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this Ordinance; and


**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that, if any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption according to law.


