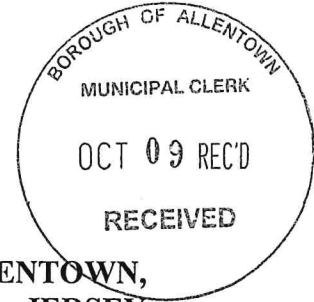

ORDINANCE NO. 18-2019



**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ALLENTOWN,
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY
SUPPLEMENTING THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 2: "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE BOROUGH
CODE WITH NEW SECTION 2-51: "GREEN TEAM ADVISORY
COMMITTEE" (PREVIOUSLY RESERVED)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Allentown, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 2: "Administration" of the Borough Code is hereby supplemented as follows with new Section 2-51 "Green Team Advisory Committee":

2-51 GREEN TEAM ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

2-51.1 Establishment.

There is hereby established in the Borough of Allentown a Green Team Advisory Committee, having the powers and duties hereinafter enumerated, whose purpose shall be to study and advise the Borough on issues of environmental and energy sustainability and meeting the goals of the Sustainable Jersey program.

2-51.2 Membership; Qualifications; Appointment; Term of Office.

- a. The Green Team Advisory Committee shall consist of eleven (11) members, all of whom shall be either:
 - i. A resident of the Borough; or
 - ii. The owner or operator of a business within the Borough; or
 - iii. An employee, official, or contractor of the Borough.

- b. The Green Team Advisory Committee membership shall be comprised as follows:
 - i. The Borough Clerk;
 - ii. The Borough Recycling Coordinator;
 - iii. The Mayor;
 - iv. One (1) Member of the Borough Council;
 - v. Two (2) Members of the Environmental Commission;
 - vi. Two (2) Members of the Shade Tree Commission;
 - vii. One (1) Member of the Economic Development Commission;
 - viii. One (1) Member of the Board of Recreation Commissioners; and
 - ix. One (1) Member of the Planning Board;

2-51.5 Expenditure of Funds.

The Borough Council may annually appropriate funds for the use of the Green Team Advisory Committee, and such funds may be expended on the authority and approval of the Green Team Advisory Committee upon submission of proper vouchers to the Borough CFO.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by Mayor and Council that should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to that end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by Mayor and Council that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies only.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by Mayor and Council that this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after final passage and publication, as required by law.
