

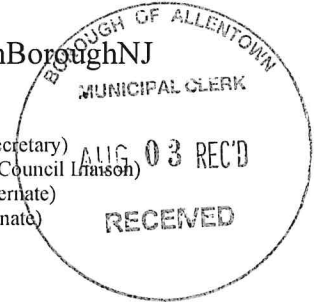

Call to Order by Chairperson Craig Rondinone at 7:01pm and the following statement was read

1. Salute to Flag
2. "In Compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" Chapter 231, PL. 1975, Section 5, adequate notice has been given of the meeting by posting a Notice in a public place and by transmitting a Notice to two newspapers, THE TIMES and the ASBURY PARK PRESS, as required by law."
3. Roll call was performed by Craig Rondinone
4. Minutes Review and Approval – Minutes from May 2020 minutes were approved by Joe Sensi and second by Mark Jaskowski
5. Historic Allentown 5K discussion
 - a. Craig Rondinone provided a summary of options for the 5K for either live or virtual race.
 - i. Due to the work load on a live race, we would need to make a decision either this month or next month.
 - b. Eileen Kuzma communicated her concerns about having a live 5k stating safety for our community is important and feel that we should go virtual race. Proposed sending out a survey to prior years participants (Mark & Michael agreed with survey).
 - c. Mark Jaskowski communicated things are every changing and maybe we should wait to change this race to virtual.
 - d. Joe Sensi feels that we should be conservative and go towards virtual race.
 - e. Diana Bamford communicated her concerns about getting people to do a virtual race and also reminded the group that we could push the race.
 - f. Barbara Pleva communicated concerns about going live. Also communicated the concern about any losses due to cancelling the race at the last minute.
 - g. Rob Schmitt mentioned that the county might not like closing the roads twice in one day.
 - h. Shawn Noel communicated that if we don't have it live, then maybe we should cancel the race.
 - i. The members voted to hold or virtual, it was unanimous that we would hold off until next month after we survey the prior year runners.
 - i. Craig will pull together the survey and communicate the findings prior to the meeting.
6. Old Business
 - a. Discussed options on spending funds from our budget.
 - i. See if the Boy Scotts could do some work on the trails in heritage park and make a donation for work that is done. Mike to reach out to Rob, to see if they would be willing to work on the trails.
 - ii. Suggested a drive-in movie night at the school parking lot. Shawn Noel to look into the cost. Once we get the cost for the movie we would need to get approval from the school (Will offered to be our liaison with the school board) and get security.
