

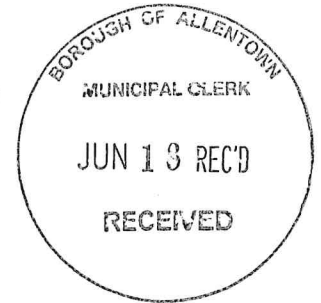

 - d. Laurie A Roth would be able to assist with any insurance or legal issue.
 - e. Summary, the board is concerned about safety of the volunteers and participants. We feel that it is too early in the year to make a decision and the board would like to wait to make a decision.
 - f. Craig Rondinone will get additional information about the Virtual Race so that we can make a decision in June.
6. Budget Update for 2020
 - a. Michael Drennan communicated that we got an additional \$1,500 added to our 2020 Budget.
 - b. We will need to discuss some events options for 2021 during the June.
