Call to Order by Chairperson Craig Rondinone at 7:01pm and the following statement was read

1. Salute to Flag
2. "In Compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" Chapter 231, PL. 1975, Section 5, adequate notice has been given of the meeting by posting a Notice in a public place and by transmitting a Notice to two newspapers, THE TIMES and the ASBURY PARK PRESS, as required by law."
3. Roll call was performed by Craig Rondinone
4. Minutes Review and Approval – Minutes from February 2021 approved by Joe Sensi and seconded by Barbara Pleva
5. Craig informed the Rec. Commission members that meeting for the second quarter (April, May and June) would continue to be held via Zoom and not in person.
6. Rec. Commission officially approved applications for the Allentown Easter Egg Hunt and Upper Freehold Soccer to use Farmers Park for practices.
7. Drive-in Movie Night – Craig talked to Amanda and Armmel from the PTA. He said the PTA wanted to have the Movie Night earlier than last year's and preferably during summer months. Craig said he would be in contact with Premiere Productions regarding their availability once the PTA chose a date.
8. Historic Allentown 5K Update – Craig said he spoke to Bill Boyijian from Best Race and that he was available to do the timing for the race on September 25th. Craig asked if Michael Drennan he could start designing the course. Craig also said he would contact Allentown Clerk Laurie Roth about getting the proper paperwork for the race.
9. Old Business -- Michael Drennan confirmed that the Recreation Commission budget for 2021 would be \$1,500. That is apart from the money also currently in the Rec. Commission's trust fund.
10. New Business – Michael Drennan asked if the Rec. Commission would be willing to pay for the cost of repairing/replacing the backboards at the Farmers Park basketball court. The cost would be approximately \$600-\$650. The Commission approved paying for the improvements. Craig also asked members to send him their updated contact information so he could put together an updated list for 2021.
