NOTICE OF ORDINANCE INTRODUCTIONS

Ordinance 02-2026, “An Ordinance Augmenting Chapter 3: “Police Regulations” of the Borough’s Revised General Ordinances to Create New Section 3-4: “Trespass” to Prohibit Trespass Upon All Properties Where Notice Against Tresspass is Given,” was introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Governing Body of the Borough of Allentown, NJ, held on Tuesday, February 10, 2026. This ordinance gives the Allentown Police Department the ability to charge fines to people who trespass on private property.

Ordinance 03-2026, “An Ordinance Amending Chapter 23: “Parks and Recreation Areas” of the Borough’s Revised General Ordinances To Create Section 23-1.12: “Ice-Related Activities Prohibited” to Prohibit Ice Skating, Ice Fishing, and Other Ice-Related Activities Within Borough Parks and Recreation Areas,” was introduced and passed upon the first reading at a regular meeting of the Governing Body of the Borough of Allentown, held on Tuesday, February 10, 2026. This ordinance will ban all ice-related activities from Borough parks with the exception of the multi-purpose court in Dr. Farmer’s Park.

Ordinance 04-2026, “An Ordinance An Ordinance to Exceed the Municipal Budget Appropriations Limits and to Establish a Cap Bank (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14),” was introduced and passed upon the first reading at a regular meeting of the Governing Body of the Borough of Allentown, held on Tuesday, February 10, 2026. This ordinance allows the Borough to This ordinance allows the Borough to exceed the municipal budget appropriation limits for calendar year 2025 and establishes a cap bank.

These ordinances will further be considered for final passage after a public hearing scheduled for each ordinance at a meeting of the Governing Body to be held at the Allentown Borough Hall, 8 N. Main St., Allentown, NJ 08501 on Tuesday, February 24, 2026 at 6:30p.m. or as soon thereafter.
